About the position:

Counsellors are accountable to the House Manager for delivery of Renascent Program services to individuals suffering from addiction to alcohol and/or other drugs or food addiction. The position includes, but is not restricted to, screening, assessment, and intake of people referred to the program for treatment, to determine their suitability for our program. The position may involve referral to detoxification facilities prior to admission to Renascent, or referral to more appropriate services elsewhere.

Key Responsibilities:

- Screening, assessment, and intake of people referred to the program for treatment, to determine their suitability for our program. May involve referral to withdrawal management services prior to admission to Renascent, or referral to more appropriate services elsewhere.
- Implements systematic, ongoing goal setting with clients, which includes specific planning and establishment of courses of action to accomplish goals, in consultation with the Counselling Team.
- Frequently and regularly assesses clients' progress.

- Provides skill-enhancement through role modelling and general instruction.
- Provides systematic, structured counselling to individuals and groups in relation to specific program materials and issues.

Qualifications:

- Lived experience of addiction and recovery and active involvement in a 12-step program for addiction required.
- A minimum of three years of continuous recovery is preferred.
- Excellent communication skills, both oral and written, are essential, including an ability to share life experience for the benefit of the clients.
- University degree or college diploma in one of the social sciences or a health related discipline, or the equivalent in work experience.
- Completion of course-work for certification as an Addictions Counsellor is required.
